NOVEMBER 29, 2011

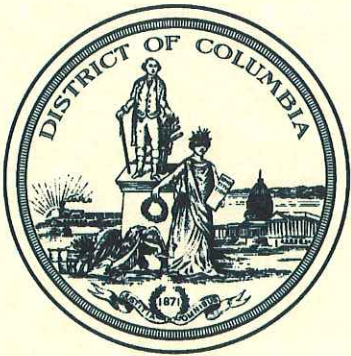
WHEREAS, since its inception, the Junior Achievement program has helped over 600,000 young people in the Greater Washington Metropolitan area; and
