Executive Summary

Introduction

On September 11, 2001 the United States suffered the worst terrorist attack in its history. Worse yet, the attack was aimed at symbols of the American way of life, occurring on U.S. soil and causing massive loss of life. Nationwide, people of all creeds, nationalities, and ages were profoundly impacted by the events of September 11.

Junior Achievement is dedicated to teaching our youth about the American way of life. With a renewed focus on young people, Junior Achievement attempted to gauge, in part, just how recent events have shaped teen-agers' views of their futures and of our economy. The results may surprise you.

The following poll was taken of teen-agers online, in their classrooms, in the weeks immediately following the national tragedy.

Last year, a Junior Achievement survey of teens on the American Dream found that three out of four teen-aged Americans believed that our treasured freedoms, won through the American Revolution and guaranteed in the Constitution, are at the root of our nation's collective dream. According to that poll, 587 students surveyed by Junior Achievement as part of the *Interprise Poll*[™] series believed that the American Dream meant the freedom to choose how to live your life.

Through a separate poll on Summer Jobs, we also learned that teens are regularly doing something to attain that dream. Certainly, teens go to school. But, for better or worse, they also work. In fact, two-thirds of America's high school students held a job during the 2000-2001 school year. The stake of young people's contribution and participation in the U.S. economy is relatively small compared to the general population. Still, it is not to be underestimated. For a short while every year, teens transform into their adult counterparts: many of them work full-time during over the summer.

What does all of this mean? Teen-agers today play an important role in the economy. A recent survey by Ohio State University for the U.S. Department of Labor shows that the average teenager gets a staggering \$50 a week in disposable income from parents alone. With their consumer interests best described as focused on discretionary spending, teens have plenty to say about the U.S. economy and their roles in it after the events of September 11, 2001.

According to an online survey promoted by Junior Achievement Inc. in classrooms nationwide and administered online from September 26, 2001 to October 4, teens today say their plans for spending remains unchanged. The survey of 552 teens as part of the Special *JA Interprise Poll*[™] also revealed a patriotic generation of young consumers. They largely seem to care about the welfare of others too.

FINDINGS

Seventy three percent of teens say they would buy a U.S. war bond to support America.

The survey of 552 students revealed a patriotic generation: Nearly three out of four teen-agers (73 percent) would buy war bonds to support the U.S. government if made available.

Consumer Confidence High Among Teens

Teens aren't afraid to continue their current levels of consumer spending. According to survey results, 79 percent of young people do not plan to change their spending habits. Teen-agers are cautiously optimistic about the chances for a speedy economic recovery, too. According to a special *JA Interprise Poll* on teen perceptions of the economic impact following the events of September 11, 2001, only 37 percent of students think the U.S. economy will take "longer than a year to recover."

Future Career Choices

The events of September 11, 2001 may have profoundly affected teen perceptions of their future career choices. Ten percent of respondents said they are now more likely to consider a career in the military, eight percent of students said they were more likely to consider a career in law enforcement or fire-fighting, and six percent said they were more likely to consider non-profit work such as joining a relief organization. Among 154 less popular but still significant answers were professions such as journalist, doctor, nurse, and teacher. (In the 2000 and 2001 versions of the *JA Interprise Poll on Kids and Careers*, "doctor" has been consecutively named as the most popular career.)

Teens on Helping Others

Since September 11, 2001, Americans of all ages and backgrounds have made substantial donations to various relief organizations. The Red Cross, for example, has reported that donations have exceeded \$500 million. As the Special JA Interprise Poll did not ask students how much they gave, there is no quantifiable data to tell us what share of the national giving has come from teens. But the poll did ask respondents if they gave or planned to give of themselves.

There is growing evidence nationwide that teens are a generation quite generous with their time, effort, and now, it seems, with their money. The results indicate that the majority of today's young people want to help the national relief effort.

According to survey results, 47 percent of teens say they have given money to the national relief effort. Another 14 percent of teens say they have either raised money on their own (through fundraisers such as car washes), or "have plans" to do so.

Demographic Data

A total of 282 respondents were female (52 percent), while 262 were male (48 percent). Grade levels ranged from 7-12.

Findings by Gender

Broken down by gender, the survey results reveal more similarities than differences of opinion. Forty-four percent of girls said it would take "longer than a year" for the U.S. economy to recover, while 29.6 percent of boys thought so. However, there were no significant variances of opinion among boys and girls when asked if spending habits would change (78.2 percent and 78.8 percent, respectively), or in willingness to buy war bonds, if ever made available (72.8 percent and 73.9 percent, respectively).

Findings by Race

Sixty-four percent of respondents were white, followed by 19 percent who identified themselves as black, 7 percent who identify themselves as of mixed race, 6 percent who were Hispanic, 3 percent who were Asian, and 1 percent of Native American descent.

Only 35 percent of white students said the U.S. economy would take longer than one year to recover, while nearly half of Hispanic and black students (45.4 percent and 44.6 percent, respectively), believed the same. Hispanic students were also slightly more likely to purchase war bonds, if made available (79.4 percent of Hispanic students versus 73.8 percent of white students). The survey also revealed that 67 percent of black students would also purchase U.S. war bonds, while 64.8 percent of students identifying themselves as "mixed race" say they would do so.
